






DAY ONE

Arrival from Paris or burgundy with your private English speaking driver guide
Private guided tour of the Cathedral of Reims. Listed in the Unesco World Heritage, 13th century Notre-Dame de Reims Cathedral is one of Europe's most important Gothic structures. Let you be captivated by the unique stained glasses and the exceptionally rich statuary – over 2 300 statues among which the famous Smiling Angel.

Before lunch, we will do a sightseeing of Reims

Not to be misted the great architecture of the city with Reims city hall, Maison des Musiciens, Gallo Romain site and fun buildings of the 1920's glorious Champagne days.

Tour of an artisanal coopery.

This cooperage is the latest to make traditional barrels in Champagne. We end the tour with a glass of champagne matured in one the barrels. Great experience!

DAY TWO

Your guide drives you to the **Scenic Route du Champagne** which meanders among the vineyards and the picturesque villages. On this Champagne Day Tour you will be taken to the Côte des Blancs for a sightseeing of some of the most famous Grandes Maisons de Champagne such as: Bollinger, Gosset, Deutz, etc. En route the countryside is enamelled with beautiful Grand Cru villages like Ay, Hautvillers, Bouzy, Le Mesnil, Vernezay, etc.

Tasting Champagne Moët & Chandon

Founded in 1743 by Claude Moët it becomes within 40 year the first international brand in the world.

Lunch at your leisure in Epernay.

DAY TWO

Tour along the Avenue de Champagne in Epernay:

Located in the heart of town, Epernay is internationally known as the "Capital of Champagne". Epernay's stunning main street appears like an exhibition of opulent mansions housing the most illustrious Maisons de Champagne: Moët & Chandon, Perrier-Jouet, Mercier, etc. Not to mention the 100km of tunnels under the pavement!

Tour and tasting at a family Domaine. This Chateau located Avenue de Champagne belongs to a well-known family in the world of fine wines.

Return to your hotel mid-afternoon for a relaxing moment at the SPA.

Dinner at your leisure.

DAY THREE

Check out after breakfast.

Tour of the exquisite village of **Hautvillers**, overlooking Epernay and all the vineyards. You will see the grave of the Monk Dom Perignon in the village church.

Tour of a snail farm.

Located in the Grand Crus Champagne appellation, this snail farm produces one of the most famous French specialties, the snails. During the tour, you get to understand how we grow and prepare those delicious little animals.

At the end of the tour, escargot tasting accompanied with a glass of Champagne Grand Cru of course.

Tour of Villa Demoiselle and final champagne tasting!

The Villa Demoiselle is a nice example of 1920's Art Deco style.

Drive along the picturesque vineyard roads to Reims.
